Solar System donated by local solar company to benefit Sedona Film Festival

Arizona Solar Power of Cottonwood, Arizona and the Sedona International Film Festival have teamed up to support Greening the Festival, the Sustainability Film Series, Sustainability Round table, the Sedona Institute for Sustainability & Transformative Media – SISTM, as well as awards for Sustainable film makers.

Matthew Bonnstetter, Store Manager for Arizona Solar Power's Cottonwood/Corporate location has been working with Patrick Schweiss, Director of the Sedona International Film Festival, in order to facilitate a raffle with a prize of a \$50,000 SunPower Solar Electric PhotoVoltaic system. All proceeds benefit the film festivals efforts for Sustainable/Green film tracks and events.

“We are donating a Grid tied 5.4 kW SunPower Solar system for installation only in Arizona.” Bonnstetter said. “Anyone in America can buy a ticket. The winner can donate or assign the system to a home, business or place of worship. All utility rebates go to us, and we give them a \$50,000 check, so they can buy the system from us in order to take full advantage of all tax incentives offered by the state and federal governments.”

Ticket prices are \$20 each, or six for \$100. The public is encouraged to buy quickly, as only 3,000 tickets will be sold.
